



Financial Aid Scholarship

About the Scholarships

Financial assistance is available for families who demonstrate need. Through generous donors to the "Angel Fund," CCT is able to grant young students this assistance.

To apply, use the link below to download the Financial Aid Scholarship Application. Please note, applications are due no later than three weeks prior to the first day of class. Funds are granted on a first come first serve basis.

The application turn-around time will vary depending upon the enrollment of the classes for which you are seeking aid. If a class or camp has met its minimum enrollment at the time of receipt, the application will be processed. If the class has the potential to be canceled due to low enrollment, application processing may be delayed or applicant may be asked to apply for a different class.

Scholarship Requirements

In order to be considered for scholarship, families may not exceed the incomes outlined on the chart below.*

* Extenuating circumstances may occasionally result in eligibility. If your family does not meet the above requirements, you may still apply. Please indicate said circumstances on the application form.

** Household includes all people living in your household, related or not (such as relatives, grandparents, friends, etc). You must include yourself in the total.

Conditions of Scholarship and Retention

- Scholarship applications must be on time and complete for consideration.
- Registration and partial scholarship fees must be turned in before the first day of class. **CCT Teaching Artists cannot accept payment.**
- Students must arrive on time for class. Excessive tardiness could affect future scholarship eligibility and may result in dismissal from class.
- Inappropriate behavior may affect future scholarship eligibility.
- A new application must be filled out for each class session—scholarship eligibility does not carry over.
- Scholarships are limited to one per student per class session with the exception of summer session in which a student may be awarded up to two scholarships.



How To Apply

1. Review CCT Academy's brochure or online catalog of offerings and select the best class(es) and/or camp(s) for your child.
2. Check to see that your family meets the requirements outlined in the following section.
3. Fill out the attached application and return to CCT by the deadline. Applications must be filled out *completely* and turned in no later than three weeks prior to the first day of class. Please double check you have filled out the application completely. **Under no circumstances will an incomplete application be considered.** Applications will be reviewed in the order they are received.
4. If your child is awarded a scholarship, you will receive notification by **email**. At that time, the registration fee and any partial scholarship fees will be due.
5. Any student with unpaid fees on the first day of class will be removed from the roster and will not be eligible to participate.
6. Applicants may qualify for up to 2 classes per session during the school year, and up to 4 classes during the summer.
